A retainer of one-half the amount contracted for, in addition to the service agreement, is due to begin the project. The balance, including costs for photocopies, certificates, other out-of-pocket expenses and state sales tax, if applicable, is due upon receipt of the report.

Vital Records, obituaries, etc.

Single Vital Records are available from microfilms prior to 1900. These are \$20.00 each. Certified state copies from 1 July 1897 to the present are available. By state law only certified copies of vital records are now issued by state and local registrars. The cost for a search for a certified copy of a state **marriage** or **death** record is \$25 for the first record and \$20 for subsequent records (this includes \$5 for the cost of the certificate and postage). For **births**, the first record is \$35 and subsequent records are \$30 each (this includes \$15 for the cost of the certificate and postage). There is a 6% sales tax charged for research for Connecticut residents. If I do not find the record you pay only for the research in each case. You may also purchase a written extraction of the information in each record for a flat rate of \$20 for each birth, marriage, death, obituary or other record. Payment is requested in advance, please. If you have a number of copies you need, an hourly research rate will probably be more economical, and I will charge the lower fee.

Note: After the introductory offer is fulfilled, continuing research hours are billed at \$55 per hour. Out-of-pocket costs are extra; Connecticut residents add 6.0% state sales tax. *If there is time left over from any search, I will credit you or refund the difference to you.* This offer is available only to beginning individuals, not commercial companies.
